Kirsty is Glenabank's Deputy Manager and Dave is one of the homes handymen.

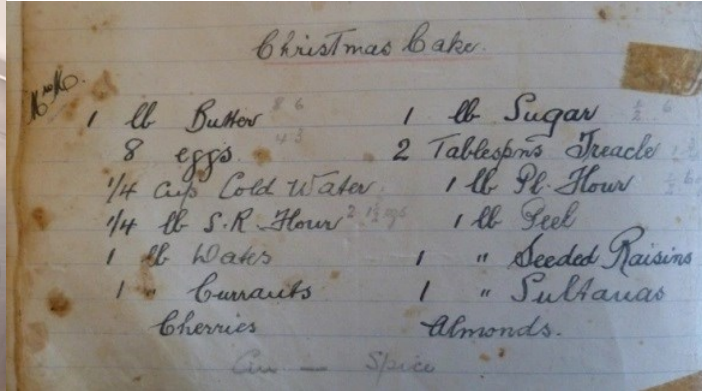
