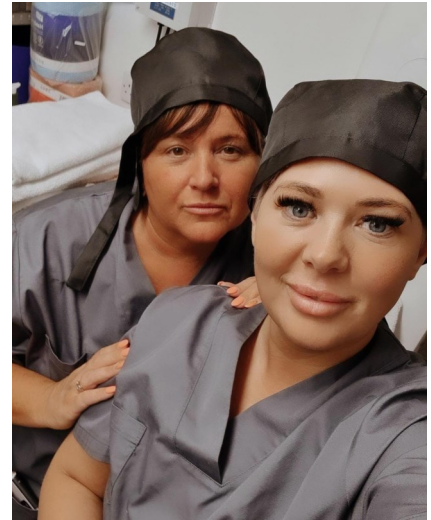


One of the nice things about being next to a nature reserve is some of the wildlife that come to visit us.
