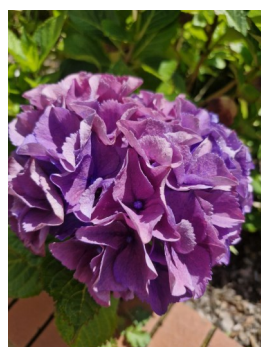

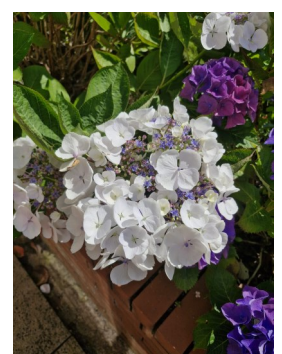

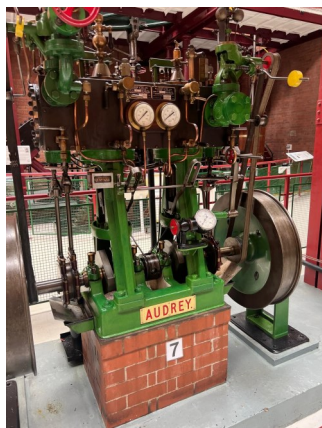
The garden is also blooming, bringing in butterfly's and bees.
