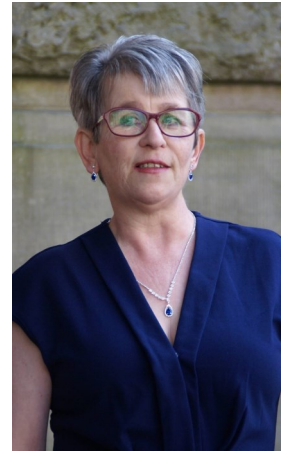

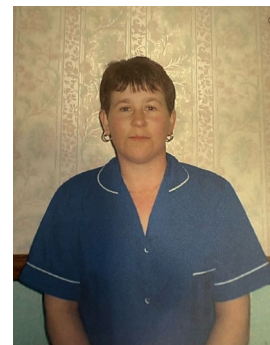
Staff Profile



Everyone at Glenbank would like to wish Lynn a Happy 60th Birthday.

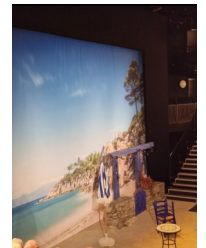

Improvements

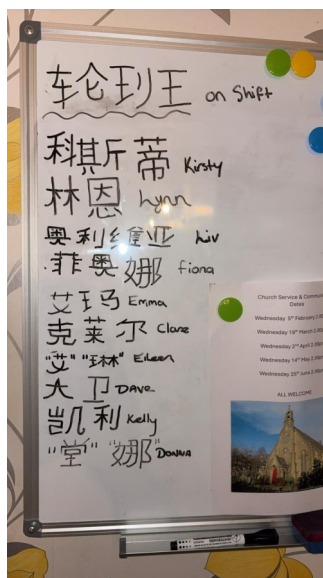
We have finally removed the Covid visiting pod from the carpark.

Visiting Professionals Survey Results

Comments from surveys included:

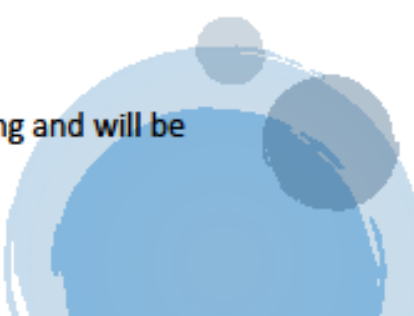
The atmosphere at Glenbank is always very positive. There are notice boards around the home advertising regular activities.
